

# Minnesota State Fair Grandstand Ramp Project Elements

**About:** The Minnesota State Fair Grandstand Ramp (1937) is a 335-ft. by 35-ft. walkway accented by 10 towers leading to the second floor of the historic Grandstand. This project will achieve the original architectural vision for the historic ramp by installing 70 recessed groove lights, upgrading the 10 tower lights and replacing safety fencing with more historically accurate materials.

New tower lighting will be true to historic intent with low-energy consumption.



Installation of 70 groove lights, ranging in size from 46" to 213" long, also including a new wire-way and connectivity to an underground electrical vault.

Chain link safety fencing at the ramp's highest elevation to be replaced with more historically accurate materials.
